Even though we are not mandating hours for this year, we are a service based organization. Here are 4 different opportunities for service to those in need via Interfaith Family Housing – one of our Community Services:



Casseroles



You can make a casserole for Interfaith Family Housing. We need casseroles every month for the various new families and for group activities that they do. Please make one that serves 8 to 12 and be sure to include the recipe with the casserole so that they will have ready knowledge of all ingredients.

Don't have a lot of time or interest in cooking? You can use a ready-made casserole (like Stouffer's Lasagna) and use it.

You can either:

1. Buy a casserole and bring it to **Tasca Feibel** for delivery.

You get 1 hour credit.

2. Cook a casserole from your recipes and bring the casserole with the recipe attached on the outside to **Tasca Feibel** (75 Abbey Woods Lane, Dallas, Tx. 75248). I will deliver it.

You get 2 hours credit

3. If you live in the vicinity of Interfaith, you can cook the casserole (with recipe on outside), and deliver it to their facility and put it in their freezer. You get 3 hours credit.
